Important Contact and Supervision Information

Questions or concerns around Athletes – non medical related:

- Please contact Leah Anderson at 250-622-4617 who will be on call 24 hours a day.

Transportation:

- Transport athlete to and from his/her sport venue, if it is not within walking distance.
- Transport athlete to and from his/her special event on Friday and Saturday evening.
- Athletes can access the Prince Rupert & Port Edward transit buses for free with their accreditation badges.
- Sports competitions run Friday morning, February 5 to Sunday, February 7, 2010.
All participants will receive a competition schedule in their accreditation kits.

- All regional buses depart at 12 noon on Sunday, February 7, 2010 from the Civic Center Parking Lot.

Meals:

- Provide dinner on Thursday, Friday and Saturday evenings (February 4 to February 6, 2010).
- Provide breakfast on Friday, Saturday and Sunday mornings (February 5 to February 7, 2010).
- Athletes are to provide their own lunches.

Supervision:

- Provide basic parental supervision.
- Games Society curfew is 12:00 MIDNIGHT – however, should you require an earlier curfew, you may take into consideration the athlete's competition times. Any violations of curfew **MUST** be reported to the Host Community Games Office *immediately*. (250-624-6684)

Alcohol, drugs, gambling or betting will not be tolerated – any athlete in violation **MUST** be reported to the Host Community Games Office *immediately*. (250-624-6684)

Health & Medical Concerns:

If a billeting athlete has any health issues and / or requires any medical attention, you **MUST** report this to the Prince Rupert Northern BC Winter Games Clinic or Medical Director. Please contact the Medical Clinic or Director if an athlete:

- does not attend a venue due to complaints of feeling unwell;
- shows symptoms of an illness or health issue;
- sustains an injury;
- is taken to the hospital for any reason, be it injury or illness.
